Navajeevan Blind Relief Centre ([www.navajeevan.org](http://www.navajeevan.org)), based out of Tirupati in Andhra Pradesh, India, runs a school for the visually impaired (nearly 150 children); an orphanage (approximately 50 children), a charitable home for the aged and an eye hospital. All the children are from economically backward communities and more than 70% of the children are girls. The Centre has been operating for over 40 years and has been providing some of these services in the remote districts of Andhra Pradesh and Orissa in India. The centre has helped rehabilitate over 10,000 children with vision impairment in addition to providing medical care to more than 500,000 people. This service has been of great benefit to the people in these under-served regions of India.

For the above long services Government of India, recognized our services and presented a National Award recently by the President of India.
